- Date code is printed on the warning statement affixed to the gauge
- This is a 4 digit date code
- First 2 digits are the year of manufacture (taking the last 2 digits of the year. EX: 15 would be 2015)
- Second 2 digits are the week of manufacture

- Second 2 digits are the year of manufacture (taking the last 2 digits of the year. EX: 15 would be 2015)

They are coded with the week first and the year second where all others are yr/wk.
